## Brief History



- ◆ Established on 02/22, 2006 by merging
  - ✓ Directorate General of Telecom of MoTC
  - ✓ Department of Broadcasting Affairs of GIO
- ◆ Independent regulatory authority that oversees telecom and media businesses

## Commission


- ◆ **Directed by seven Commissioners**
  - ✓ Appointed by Premier, upon approval of legislators
  - ✓ 4-year term, with possibility of consecutive terms
  - ✓ Background: telecom, media, economics, law
- ◆ **Chairperson and Vice Chairperson are determined by internal election among Commissioners**
- ◆ **At least one Commission Meeting is held every week**



## Bilateral Cooperation with U.S.

### ◆ APEC TEL MRA Phase I

Under APEC TEL framework, Taiwan has signed Phase I MRA (Mutual Recognition of Testing Laboratories and Mutual Acceptance of Test Reports) with U.S. in 1999

### ◆ Strengthen bilateral cooperation with U.S. on specific telecom issues in international organizations, such as APEC and WTO

Taiwan is looking forward to participating in ITU-R WRC

## Bilateral Cooperation with FCC

### ◆ NCC & AIT held a video conference with FCC

On May 7, 2009, NCC and AIT invited Dr. Donald K. Stockdale, Jr, Deputy Chief and Bureau Chief Economist of the Wireline Competition Bureau, and Dr. Jonathan D. Levy, Deputy Chief Economist of FCC, to share regulatory policies on digital convergence and competition issues
