


Distribution of Telecom Revenue by Services in 2015




Note 1: Total revenue of telecom services reached NTD371 billion in 2015.

Note 2: 4G service has been provided since May 2014.




Data Communication Revenue - as proportion of Total Telecom Revenue



Note: The items of data communication revenue include revenue of mobile data service, internet service, value-added services and leased circuit service.




Mobile Data Service Revenue - as proportion of Total Mobile Revenue

Telecom Subscribers by Services




Note 1: Mobile cellular subscribers added subscriptions of WBA from 2010, and 4G from 2014.

Telecom Services Subscribers per 100 inhabitants





Fixed Broadband Subscribers -by Technologies




- Proportion of Prepaid Card Subscribers



Note: The Proportion of Prepaid Card Subscribers has included 4G prepaid card subscribers from 2014.




Evolution of Mobile Market




Internet access via 3G and 4G mobile networks






Volume of mobile voice communications has overtaken fixed since 2007
